From the Proprietor

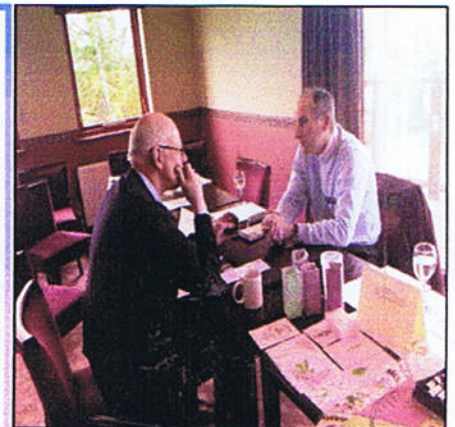
