#### On the Course

The photos show the greenkeeping team top-dressing our greens earlier in July . This is something that would normally have been done earlier in the season but was delayed due to extremely wet weather that we had in May . A suitable "window of opportunity" was then required to get the work done, whilst offering as little disruption as possible to the golfing programme. Top-dressing is an essential activity smoothing out any imperfections in the greens thus providing a truer surface over time.

Although our irrigation system has been used to good effect over recent weeks, due to a computerised failure, we have been unable to control the system to operate automatically overnight. This has meant that our greenstaff have had to manually switch on the popups in the early mornings. Although the greens have still had the water required, we know that overnight watering gives better results (not to mention freeing up man-hours). We are still awaiting additional computer parts in order to get full automatic system back working properly but this should be sorted in the next two weeks.
