

## **SPECIFIC FORMAT AND RULES FOR THE CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS**

### **1) GROSS AND NETT CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP(MEN)**

- The format will be 3 balls off full playing handicap.
- Entrants must have designated Mile End as their Home Club
- The competition will be a 36 Hole competition played over 2 days (18 holes per day).
- Tee-times will be decided by the Competitions Committee and there will be a separate sheet published for each day for entrants to choose their preferred time.
- The entrance fee will be decided by the Club Committee and is payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> day only.
- Competitors will be expected to sign as directed by the competitions committee. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- It is the player's responsibility to sign themselves in. It is no defence that it was agreed that someone else would sign them in and failed to do so.
- The Man recording the lowest combined Gross Score over the 36 holes will be deemed to be The Gross Club Champion
- The Man recording the lowest combined Nett Score over the 36 holes will be deemed as The Nett Club Champion.
- There will also be prizes given to the Best Gross on both Day 1 and Day 2 and also the Best Nett on Day 1 and Day 2.
- A maximum of one prize per person may be won. A player having won one prize then becomes an ineligible entrant in subsequent awards. The hierarchy of awards will be Gross Club Champion. Nett Club Champion, Gross Day 1 Champion, Gross Day 2 Champion, Nett Day 1 Champion, Nett Day 2 Champion.
- In the event of one of the days being cancelled or abandoned then the Competitions will be decided over 1 round of 18 Holes. In the event of the whole competition being called off then it will be re-played at a later date to be decided by the Competitions Committee.
- In the event of a tie in the Gross there will be an 18 Holes play- off to be played on a date convenient to all participants. In the event of a further tie there will be a play-off over holes 15 to 18. In the event of a further tie there will be a sudden death play-off starting at the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- In the event of a tie in the Nett Championships the winner will be decided on Count-Back of 18,9,6,3,2,1 holes.
- No on course practice will be allowed on the Friday before the competition once the pins have been set.
- Handicaps will not be adjusted until the 36 holes have been completed.
- The Club Championship will be open to Junior's with a playing handicap of 28 and below.

- Players with a non-competition handicap are prevented from entering this competition.
- Any entrant failing to attend on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Day will be deemed not to have completed the Championships and will be subject to any disciplinary action that the Competitions Committee deem fit.

**2) GROSS AND NETT CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS(LADIES)**

- The Ladies Club Championships will be governed by the same rules as the Men's Competition with the exception of the fact that there will only be 2 prizes awarded, those being the Ladies Gross Club Champion and the Ladies Nett Club Champion. In the event of a tie then the competition will be decided as per the rules for the Mens Club Championship

**3) GROSS AND NETT CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS(SENIORS)**

- The seniors club championship will be governed by the same rules as the Mens Competition except that:
- Both the Gross and Nett Club Championships will be played over 1 round of 18 holes.
- The competition is open to Male Seniors over the age of 55 on the day of the competition.
- The player with the best gross score will be deemed the Senior Club Gross Champion. In the event of a tie then the competition will be decided as per the rules for the Club Gross Championship  
The player with the best Nett score will be deemed the Senior Club Nett Champion. In the event of a tie then the competition will be decided as per the rules for the Club Nett Club Championship.
- In the event of the competition being abandoned, for example due to bad weather, the competition will be re-arranged at a later date in the Club Calendar.
